## **Guidelines**

- New! There is **no longer a fee** to join the directory.
- Must be able to work with schools and community groups in Anne Arundel County.
- Artists may submit up to three programs for their listing.
- <u>First-time applicants</u>: if you are not currently listed on the roster of Artivate, Arts
  for Learning Maryland, and/or Maryland State Arts Council, you will need to submit
  a resume, three references and a letter of support from a school where you have
  worked along with your application.
- Returning applicants: if you are currently listed in our directory, please **fill out an** application whether or not your listing needs to be updated.
- Directory applications will be available starting August 1, 2024 and will be accepted throughout the year on a rolling basis.
- Teaching artist directory listings must be verified by the artist on a yearly basis.
