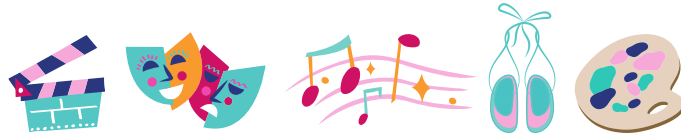


Teaching Artist Directory



The Arts Council of Anne Arundel County's Arts in Education Teaching Artist Directory is a resource for local schools, libraries and other programs to connect with the variety of teaching artists from the visual, performing, historic and literary arts.

Guidelines

- New! There is no longer a fee to join the directory.
- Must be able to work with schools and community groups in Anne Arundel County.
- Artists may submit up to three programs for their listing.
- First-time applicants: if you are not currently listed on the roster of Artivate, Arts for Learning Maryland, and/or Maryland State Arts Council, you will need to submit a resume, three references and a letter of support from a school where you have worked along with your application.
- Returning applicants: if you are currently listed in our directory, please fill out an application whether or not your listing needs to be updated.
- Directory applications will be available starting August 1, 2024 and will be accepted throughout the year on a rolling basis.
- Teaching artist directory listings must be verified by the artist on a yearly basis.

How to Apply

- Applications must be submitted online through the Arts Council's Submittable page which can be found at: artscouncilofannearundelcountynew.submittable.com/submit
